

Rental Information

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

At handover of the vehicle, the renter and the driver must present an identity card or passport, a driving licence from an EU/EEA state (including Switzerland) that is valid in Germany and entitles the holder to drive the vehicle, and a valid means of payment accepted by us. Photocopies and digital documents are not accepted.

A driving licence not issued in Latin script (Arabic, Japanese, Cyrillic, etc.) must be presented together with an international driving permit. For driving licences from countries that are not party to the international driving-licence conventions, a certified translation is required in addition to the original licence.

Driving licences from non-EU/EEA states are accepted if

- a) no visa is entered in the renter's/driver's passport, or
 - b) the renter/driver holds a visa and, at the time of rental, has not been staying in an EU/EEA state for longer than 6 months.
- After a stay of more than 6 months in an EU/EEA state, a driving licence from an EU/EEA state must be presented.

MINIMUM AGE AND DRIVING LICENCE

The minimum age depends on the vehicle and is shown in the booking process and in the rental agreement. All drivers must have held their driving licence for at least 3 years.

MEANS OF PAYMENT

We accept Visa and Mastercard credit cards, Maestro/V-PAY cards and cash. The means of payment must be issued in the renter's name and remain valid for at least 30 days after return of the vehicle.

DEPOSIT

A deposit must be provided as security at handover – in cash or by Visa or Mastercard credit or debit card.

The amount of the deposit depends on the rented vehicle. For renters whose main residence is in Germany or Austria, the following applies:

Ferrari, Lamborghini, Porsche GT3: **EUR 5,000**

Audi R8, Mercedes-AMG G63: **EUR 3,500**

For renters whose main residence is in any other country, the deposit equals the excess under the fully comprehensive insurance, which can be found in the booking process. In this case, the deposit must be provided by credit card; cash and debit cards are not accepted for this purpose.

The renter's own car may also be provided as a deposit. The registration certificates Part I & II, all vehicle keys and the vehicle itself must be handed in at our premises in Grünwald. The vehicle must be registered in the renter's name, be no more than 8 years old and be registered in Germany; its value must be at least EUR 20,000 and is determined using the DAT vehicle valuation tool. A security-transfer agreement (Sicherungsübereignung) must be signed.

The deposit applicable to your rental is shown above and on the front page of the rental agreement.

FEES AND FLAT RATES

Refuelling: If the vehicle is not returned with a full tank, we charge **EUR 5.50 per litre** of fuel.

Processing of administrative offences: For processing enquiries concerning culpable traffic violations or interferences with possession, we charge **EUR 50 per violation**.

Special cleaning (e.g. in the event of a violation of the smoking ban or excessive soiling): **EUR 200**

Additional drivers and excess kilometres: as shown in the booking process and the rental agreement

For all flat rates, you remain free to prove that no expense or damage, or significantly lower expense or damage, was incurred.

SMOKING BAN

Smoking is prohibited in all vehicles. In the event of a violation, the special-cleaning flat rate stated above is charged.

INSURANCE

The insurance cover for the rented vehicle comprises third-party liability insurance with a maximum sum insured of EUR 100 million for personal injury and property damage. The maximum sum insured per injured person is EUR 8 million and cover is limited to Europe. The excess under the third-party liability insurance is EUR 1,000 per claim.

The contractual limitation of liability (fully comprehensive cover) and the renter's obligations are governed by the General Rental Terms and Conditions (Sections D to F). Your excess is shown in the booking process and on the front page of the rental agreement.

JOURNEYS ABROAD

Use abroad is permitted in the following countries: Germany, Austria, Switzerland. Use in other countries is subject to a prior request and possible only under special conditions.

DELIVERY TO AN ADDRESS OF YOUR CHOICE

The cost of delivery and collection depends on the distance; the exact price is shown by the delivery-cost calculator in the booking process and on our website.

We reserve the right, after reservation of the vehicle, to charge an additional advance payment of up to 50 % of the total rental price on account of the delivery.

WHAT TO DO IN THE EVENT OF DAMAGE

After an accident, theft, fire or wildlife damage, **always call the police** – even for minor damage and for self-inflicted accidents without third-party involvement. Do not acknowledge any fault and do not leave the scene of the accident until all findings could be made. Notify us immediately at **+49 377 997 561**.
